

## Crochet Clutch Triangular Bag Pattern

US Terms

Multiple of 2 plus 1

2 Row repeat

### Abbreviations

ch – chain

slst – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

wst – waistcoat stitch (or knitstitch)

st – stitch

### Body of the Bag

- Chain: 65 (kind of tight chains)
- Join the 2 ends of chain together slst and ch 1.
- 1st Row: Place 1 sc in each ch. In the end insert hook into the ch. of previous row and slst.
- 2nd Row: Place your 1<sup>st</sup> sc into the 1<sup>st</sup> st. and place a stitch marker. Place 1 wst into the next st. Repeat until the end of the row.
- 3d Row: Place 1wst into the 1<sup>st</sup> st. and place a stitch marker. Place one sc. into the next st. Repeat until the end of Row.
- **4th – 30th Row:** Repeat rows 2 and 3.
- When you complete Row 30 cut yarn leaving 2m tail. Turn inside out.
- Fold to bring the stitch marker to the upper right corner and slst the two upper sides together back loops only.
- Cut your yarn, fasten off, weave in the tail.
- Turn the inside out again and fold so that the seam is hide at the back.
- Turn your work to the side and fold again so that the upper corners align in the center.
- Weave the bottom tail in and attach the zipper.
- Unfold to place the corners left and right and align the ends of the zipper in the center.
- Insert the O ring under two middles stitches at the end of the zipper where the closure is when zipped up.
- Insert the hook handle into the O ring.
- Press the lips of the zipper so that they meet and zip it up.
- Slightly fold the edges of the pyramide.
